What is an Ambry?

According to the "Catholic Culture" dictionary, an ambry is a box in which the holy oils are kept in Catholic Churches. It is either affixed to the wall or inserted in the wall of the sanctuary. (Etym. Latin *armarium*, a chest or safe.).

The oils that are kept in the ambry are the sacred oils, known as Olea Sancta in Latin and used in sacraments.

- Oil of Catechumens (oleum catechumenorum indicated by the Latin letters O.C.)
- Oil of the Sick (oleum infirmorum, O.I.), for anointing the sick.
- Oil of the Sacred Chrism (sacrum chrisma, S.C.).

Demonstrating Love

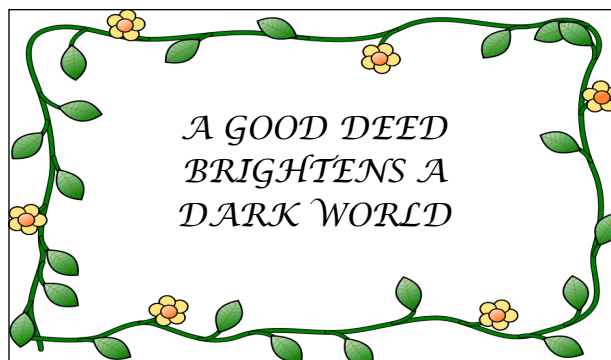
